CONSIDERATION FOR YOUR NEIGHBORS

- Check-out time 11:00 AM – Quiet Hours 10:00 PM to 7:00 AM.
- Speed Limit 10 MPH OR LESS for dust and safety's sake.
- Please conserve water, No vehicle washing.
- Absolutely NO FIREWORKS or firearms allowed at any time.
- Please NO Clotheslines; Dryers are available in two locations.
- Only one RV & one vehicle per site. Tent sites are for tenters only.
- Visitors remaining more than 1 hour or using facilities are subject to additional vehicle and person charge.
- Please inform our staff if anything needs attention to ensure everyone's enjoyment and safety.

CAMPFIRES

- No wood gathering. Do not move fire pits or grills.
- Allowed ONLY in grills and fire pits.
- Do not leave unattended, and ensure fire is completely out before retiring.

SMOKING – All buildings and pool area are smoke free. Please do not dispose of cigarette butts on the ground or in fire pits.

SWIMMING POOL – Children 14 years old and under must be accompanied by a responsible adult. THERE IS NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY; SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK. No glass or smoking anywhere inside fenced area. Abide by all rules posted at pool, all for safety's sake. **Open 10:00 AM until Dusk.***

PETS

- PLEASE be sure your owner picks up after you.
- Always have a leash connected to your owner outside your camper unless you are enjoying the exercise area.
- Stay in control. Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated.
- Stay with your owner. Never be unattended.
- Resist barking so other campers can enjoy themselves.
- A poop scoop station is located at the exercise area to quickly take care of those little acts of nature.

TELEPHONE – INTERNET

- For emergencies CALL 911 from any courtesy telephone.
- Courtesy phones are located in 3 locations shown on campground map on other side of this guide.
- Free broadband wireless internet WiFi password on registration slip.
- Free use of computer in store with high speed connection.
- Cable TV: Current channel line-up available on registration slip.
- Cell phones typically don't work on-site. However, a short walk up the dirt road across Hwy 44 usually finds a good signal and a beautiful view.

CATHOLIC AND PRESBYTERIAN SERVICES IN INTERIOR (4 miles). Schedule is posted in both laundry rooms.
