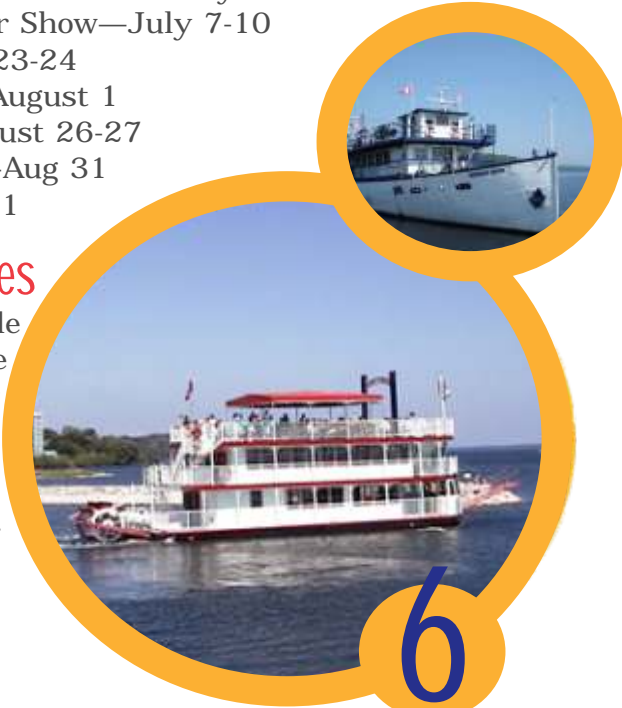
Casinos
