

GUIDELINES FOR EVERYONE'S SAFETY & ENJOYMENT

- Check-in time is 1:00pm for all campsites and accommodations. Check-out for campsites is 12 noon; Check-out for Camping Cabins and Deluxe Cabins is 11:00am. Office can assist with late check out requests.
- To ensure guest safety, it is our policy that every vehicle in the campground must be registered and have a pass displayed in the windshield.
- Our guests may have visitors between 8:00am 10:00pm. A fee is charged per person for all visiting adults and children. Visitors must register upon arrival.
- Quiet Hours are from 11:00pm-8:00am; however, please be considerate of your neighbors at all times including avoiding loud music, bright lights or walking through other sites.
- Speed limit is 9 ³/₄ MPH. Please watch for children.
- Fireworks and open-carry firearms are prohibited.
- Campfires in designated areas only. Please do not move fire rings.
- Washing vehicles or RVs is not permitted.
- Six people maximum on any site. No tents on trailer or cabin sites.
- Michigan law restricts the use of fire wood. In order to prevent the spread of invasive species, fire wood is available for purchase at the General Store.
- Dumping of raw sewage, grey water or garbage on the ground, in the woods or in a fire ring is not permitted - a dump station is available for guests not staying on full-hook up sites.
- Trash can be placed in front of your site for pick-up between 8:00am-6:00pm. After 6:00pm, please bring trash to the dumpster located behind the General Store on the left, or secure it away from our nocturnal animal "friends."
- Be Green! We recycle and encourage our guests to use our recycling center by the dumpster.
- Pets are welcome, but they must be on a leash at all times, unless inside our K-9 park. Please clean up after them, and never leave them unattended. Pets are permitted in designated Camping Cabins only, and are not permitted inside the General Store or other buildings. No aggressive breeds.
- Observe posted pool rules. Any child under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult, age 18 or older. There is NO lifeguard; swim at your own risk.
- Motor scooters, dirt bikes, or motorized carts are not allowed.
- Three day minimum stay and a full deposit is required over holidays (Memorial Day, Fourth of July and Labor Day). Cancellations made with MORE THAN two week's notice will receive a full refund, minus a \$10.00 cancellation fee. Cancellations made with LESS THAN two week's notice will receive a full refund, minus one night's stay.
- Alcoholic beverages are permitted only at campsites. Please drink responsibly and in moderation.
- · Guests who violate these rules are subject to ejection without refund.
