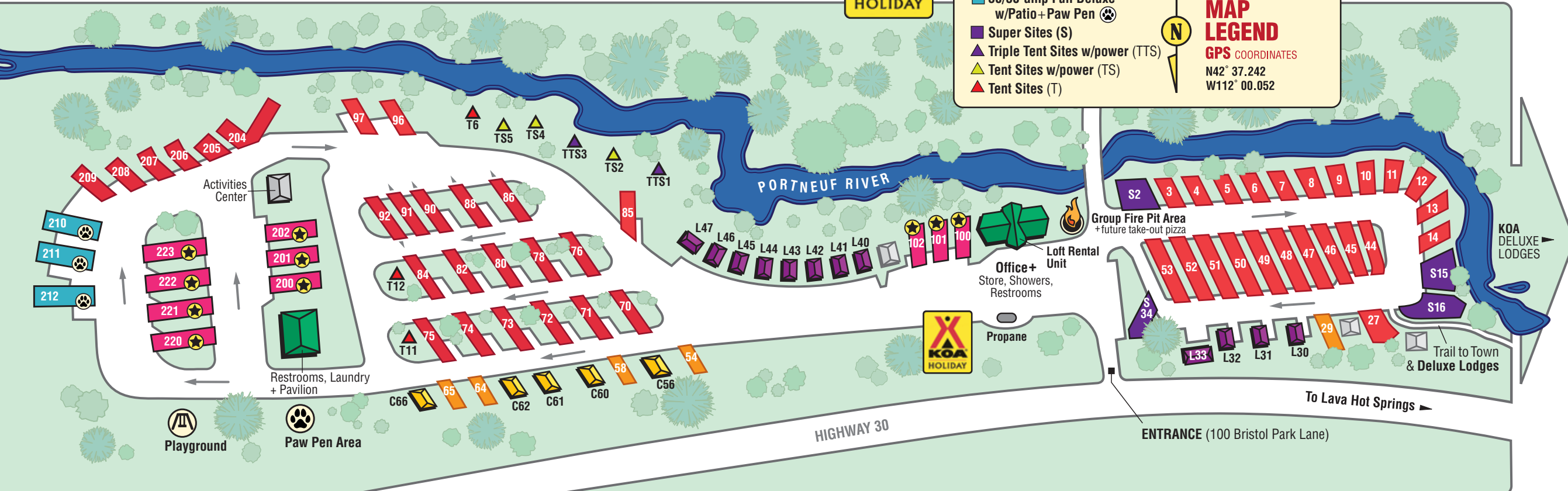

Kampground Rules

- [By signing your receipt, you verify that you will abide by these rules]
- One vehicle per campsite.** Visitors & extra vehicles should park in office parking lot and must register w/ office. \$5.00 charge for extra vehicles, excluding tow vehicles.
- Keep pets quiet and leashed at all times and promptly pick up after them.** Pets must not be left outside unattended in campsites or tents. No pets in the store or restrooms.
- Keep site clean and tidy.** A \$50 fee will be charged for removal of "unused" wood, boards, or tree limbs/branches.
- Burn only firewood** in fire pits.
- Quiet Hours** are 10 p.m. to 8 a.m.
- Check-in** is 3 p.m. **Check-out** is 11 a.m.
