


PET OWNERS Please Note...

You must have a leash no longer than 6 feet long on which your pet must be attached at one end and the owner must be attached at the other end.

# POOL RULES OPEN DAILY - NOON TO DUSK

(Weather permitting)

NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY!

NO Diapers of ANY KIND in the pool
NO Pets in Pool area.

 NO one under the age of 16 allowed in pool or pool area without parent/legal guardian.
 NO Diving! NO Running! NO Alcohol! NO Glass!

Pets — are welcomed with a leash and an owner.

Pets are an owner's responsibility NOT someone else's. Pets are to be leashed when out of their owner's kamping unit AND (with the exception of Guide Pets) are to stay OUT OF ALL

BUILDINGS and SHARED AREAS.

Pets do not like to be left alone and will share their feelings with all of your kamping neighbors!

Keep in mind that no one wants to be remembered for what their pet(s) leave behind... so, we want to "thank you" in advance for keeping their 'acts' cleaned up.

## Basic Rules:

Federal • State • Local & Kamparound

- NO Firearms, Fireworks (of any kind) Explosives or any illegal substances allowed.
- NO gray water on ground.
- EACH RV MUST HAVE a sealed sewer connection or use a rubber donut.
- A PARENT or Legal Guardian MUST ACCOMPANY CHILDREN 15 and younger in all areas.
- Because of our local noise ordinance: GENERATOR USE IS PROHIBITED.
- Due to well water supply issues: WASHING OF ANY VEHICLES IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED.
- ONLY ONE(1) RV/Camper, Tent and Vehicle per site.
- NO CLOTHESLINES Allowed. We have dryers in the Laundry that are much safer.
- Campfires allowed ONLY in FIRE RINGS! (Note: The trees and brush that surround the campground are privately owned. The owners loan us their beauty, they DO NOT give us (or you) the wood -- no matter the size.) In addition, if you (or any of your group) cut, bend, or drive nails into any of the kampground trees or foliage YOU WILL BE CHARGED A \$25.00 Property Damage Fee. To help you avoid damage fees, there is FIREWOOD FOR SALE IN THE KAMPSTORE.
- GRASS......CARPETS, RUGS, TARPS and/or VEHICLES are not allowed on GRASS. We like the greenery to grow so we can have the pleasure of cutting it! Really!
- SPEED LIMIT = 10 mph or slower! "Thanks!"
- CHECK OUT TIME is 12:00 NOON.
   If you are here after 12 Noon on the date of your scheduled departure you may be charged for another day of stay.
- POOL RULES are listed in column to the left. Please follow responsibly.
