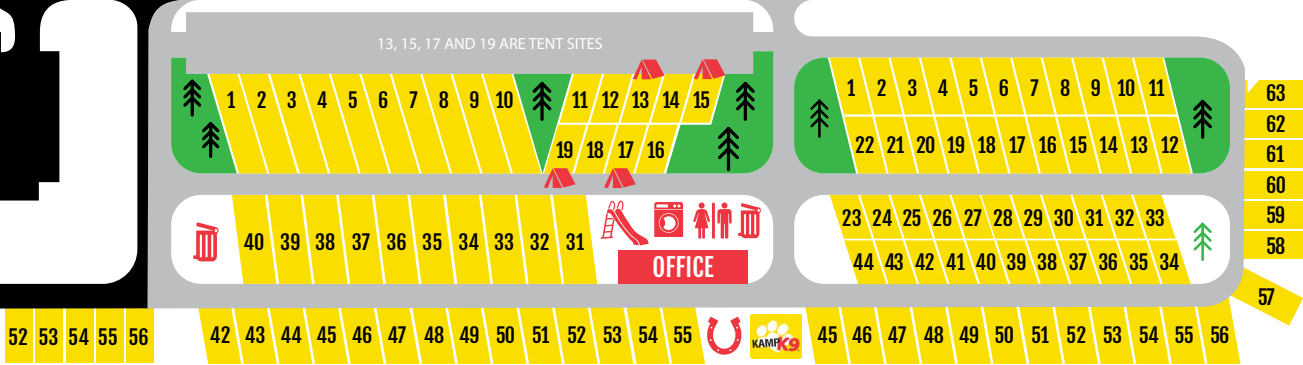

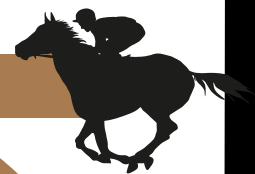

THERE'S CAMPING. AND THERE'S KOA™



The following rules and regulations will be used at the Tulsa NE/Will Rogers Downs KOA:

Camping fee receipts shall be retained by campers for the duration of their stay and shall be available for review upon request of any KOA employee.

1. Do not change your assigned site before checking with the office. Check-out Time: Noon.
2. Quiet Hours: 10PM – 7AM. Courtesy: Please respect your neighbors by keeping conversation, radio, television and musical instrument volume to a minimum. Foul language will not be tolerated.
3. Parents/Children: A parent or guardian must attend 16 and younger. Parents are responsible for children’s supervision and safety at all times.
4. Restrooms/Bathhouse: We take pride in the cleanliness of our facilities and appreciate your help maintaining them.
5. KOA has the right to ask an RV to be moved to a different site or off location at anytime.
6. RV must meet minimum appearance and safety standards.
7. Leave your site as you found it.
8. No camping or parking vehicles outside of RV and parking areas designated by KOA without consent from Management. The operation and/or parking or beyond a restrictive sign, recognizable barricades, fence or traffic control barrier is prohibited.
9. Creating or sustaining unreasonable noise at an RV site as determined by the KOA Management or KOA Security Office considering the nature and purpose of the actor’s conduct, the impact on the other users, and other factors which would govern the conduct of a reasonably prudent person under the circumstances is prohibited.
10. Do not operate generators unless park electricity is off and without consent of Management.
11. Parking an RV or vehicle in, blocking access to, occupying a designated RV site or connecting to any utilities without having first paid the fees for that RV is prohibited.
12. Placing or parking two or more vehicles on any site not designed for more than one vehicle is prohibited.
13. Camping longer than the durations of the stay noted on the camping receipt without prior written approval from the KOA RV Park Manager is prohibited.
14. No possessing or discharging fireworks or firearms on KOA property at any time.
15. Leaving outside lights on after you retire is prohibited.
16. Washing of any vehicles, including RV’s, or changing oil is strictly prohibited.
17. Open fires permitted in designated areas only.
18. Storage of parts, materials, excessive vehicles or clutter on sites is prohibited. All sites must be kept clean and neat at all times.
19. No alcoholic beverages outside of designated areas.
20. No person shall bring or allow pets onto the KOA property unless in a portable pen, caged or on a leash less than six feet in length. No person shall allow animals to bark or emit other noise, which unreasonably disturbs other people.
21. Keep pets leashed and under control at all times. Pets that display aggressive behavior will be asked to leave. You MUST clean up after your pet. Pets are not allowed in buildings. Pets should not be left unattended.
22. Please respect your fellow campers by wearing appropriate clothing when you are on the campground.

We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone. Eviction without refund may result from violation of campground rules or objectionable conduct and will be at the discretion of the management. All of these rules were made for your safety and comfort to ensure the enjoyment of all of our guests. Please obey these rules. They will be enforced.

Violations of any of these terms and conditions or any state law may result in the suspension or revocation of the use of the RV site and other penalties prescribed by law.
